ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL

The meeting was called to order by Wayne Kersey and opened with prayer. Those present in addition to Wayne were Pastor Richie, Don Wilson, Ron & Marilyn Colby, Karen Kersey, Linda Thompson, Karen Ekstrom and Don & Marilyn Morton. Motion (Ron/Don W.) carried to accept the March minutes as printed.

Treasurer's Report - The treasurer's report for March 2014 was distributed, and motion (Ron/Don M.) carried to accept the report, and thank Karen & Jeff for the great job they do with the church finances.

Trustees - The organ was repaired this past month.

The lawn mowing schedule is available for persons to sign up.

Worship - Ten new hymnals have been purchased for use in the sanctuary.

- April 16 - During Holy Week, our Book Study will be Wednesday (April 16) rather than on Thursday. No dinner.

- April 20 - Sunrise Service at the Lake, followed by breakfast at the church

Outreach - Pastor Richie & Ron Colby met with Keith McFarland and discussed ways that Lakeview could help with his outreach in Africa. Keith's missionary work in Africa is supported by some of the churches in the St. Albans area plus other aid, but the programs are limited by the funds available. One of the items that would be a big help for Keith is a laptop computer.

Lakeview had previously approved \$500 from our yard sale monies for support of Keith's work in Africa, and a motion (Ron C./Don M.) carried that we add to this amount and purchase a laptop & software for Keith in time for him to take with him on his return to Africa (June).

A committee of Don Wilson/Don Morton/Dick Thompson/Karen Kersey was appointed to look into this purchase and be prepared to present the total cost to the Board at the May meeting.

Other items that would greatly be appreciated are school supplies, soccer balls, shoes, clothes for girls, etc. Outreach Committee will make this information available to the congregation and, on an individual basis, we can contribute to this valuable missionary work.

Nurture - Sunrise Breakfast is being planned for Easter.

We will continue with *The Journey of Love* in our weekly church bulletin.

Family Ministries - Committee distributed a Lenten Calendar and now we will be collecting the money that each family contributes. Motion carried (Karen K./Ron) that this money be given to Christ's Kitchen in St. Albans.

Our soup dinners prior to our Lenten Book Study on Thursdays will continue for the next two Thursdays, April 3 and 10. Dick Thompson, John Carr and John McCormick have handled this responsibility and Lakeview is blessed to have three great cooks. There will be child care for those attending the Book Study.

Patty Moss had a Bible School Planning meeting and it went well. We will have a regular type Bible School July 13-17. The Tweens will have something more appropriate for them at the same time.
