

## ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL

**Pastor's Report -** We are still working on perhaps combining Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services in at St Albans Theater—this would be in combination with Humphreys Church. Humphreys has a Board Meeting shortly and we will be able to make a decision. The other possibility would be a combined service Christmas Eve at one church and a combined service at the other on Christmas Day.

Humphreys is having a Revival October 7-9. Pastor Tex Frye will preach and the Gospel Group from St. Paul's will sing on Friday and Saturday, 9 pm. Lakeview is invited to attend.
