Treasurer's Report – Treasurer's report for August was distributed. Noted that \$2,360 was received as a memorial for Mickey Robinette and per the families wishes, the entire amount was given to support Twin City Shelter.

Finance - Don attended a district financial meeting to help better understand the district's finances.

Our apportionment for next year went down \$300 from this year.

Plans are for the committee to meet soon and prepare the budget/pledge drive for 2018. **Family Ministries** – Children's Church currently has staff; however, we still need volunteers to cover the nursery.

Nurture- Permission has been given for a wedding/reception at our church on October 13.


Trustees – Plans are to paint the multipurpose room later in the Fall.
