Notes from the March Administrative Council Meeting, 2020

Treasurer's Report – Jeff Ekstrom

The treasurer's report for January was distributed. All bills have been paid. To date, \$3,025.00 has been donated to the LUMC in memory of Norma Newbrough. Motion made to accept the report as written (Wayne/Nicole) and was unanimously approved.

Outreach – Nicole Hender

Kid's Kits for Sojourner's: As a reminder Kid's Kits empty boxes are kept under the coat rack. Kits are to be filled with supplies (small toy, crayons, socks, etc.) See newsletter for full list. Don Griffith takes the filled boxes and Gina Griffith delivers the boxes to Sojourner's monthly. Jeff mentioned that there is \$422.86 in the Kid's Kits fund that could be used.

Lakewood Meals on Wheels (LMOW), (pronounced ELMO): LMOW is up and running (1st and 3rd Mondays). Meals were prepared and delivered to 16 members of the congregation. Meals were also made

available for the volunteers, (approximately 30 total meals.) Discussion was held to omit meals for the volunteers in the future, so more meals can be delivered. We will soon start to deliver meals outside of the congregation. Nicole recently learned of a homeless man, living in his car. Efforts will be made to send meals to him and others. The meals cost appx \$2.50 to \$3.50 per meal.

Souper Bowl Sunday was a success – A large crate and several bags of non-perishable food items were delivered to Humphreys Food Pantry.

Nicole will be recruiting volunteers for Vacation Bible School soon.

Parsonage – Marilyn Morton

The new stove, microwave and dishwasher have been installed in the parsonage. There is still a space above the microwave that needs some work, and Don will work on this.

Trustees – Dick Thompson

Dickie replaced old lights in the kitchen with LED bulbs, at a cost of \$46.00 each. The fixture was kept, just rewired. In the future, remaining lights will be replaced as they blow. A small light fixture is \$18.00 to replace with LED bulbs.

Storage: All of the closets are getting full. Volunteers will be needed to pare down and organize the items in storage. This will be done during a weeknight as a team.

Mention was again made of a piece of exercise equipment in the basement that is broken and needs to be carried out. Wayne, Richie and Jeff will carry it out tonight.
